Entry Rules

Eligibility

Registration will be open to any **Motorized Power** race boat or individual engine entry that was constructed for the purpose of competition in an organized race and which meets the classifications of historic, antique, classic or replica as defined by The Antique & Classic Boat Society and APBA Vintage and Historic Division.

Conditions and Rules

1. The entrant of any boat must agree to withdraw the boat from water operation if the **Race Director** makes such a recommendation based on any of the following:
 - a) Unsafe condition of the boat/engine
 - b) Apparent substance abuse by the driver or crew
 - c) Unsafe boat handling practices by the driver
 - d) Persistent refusal of the driver to follow the directions of the APBA Referee
 - e) The boat and driver equipment does not pass APBA safety inspection.

Please Note: Current APBA Vintage approved Life Jackets and Helmets are mandatory for both drivers and riders and must be worn in all registered boats if the race course is open.
2. Each entrant must agree to hold harmless **The Antique Boat Museum, Boat U.S. Marine Insurance** and the **American Power Boat Association**. This is an APBA Sanctioned Special Event; Exhibitors must be APBA members. Include your number for verification.
3. While registration is open by invitation on a First Come, First Served basis, the Registration Committee will attempt to achieve a balance of age and classification of race boats for both **In-Water** and **Land Display** classifications. There may be limitations in the crane area. The Registration Committee will attempt to provide space for all boats and memorabilia exhibits.
4. Any signage indicating that the boat is **For Sale** will not be permitted. A bulletin board will be provided for this purpose plus there will be a designated marketplace area where boats can be offered for sale.
5. The Registration Committee reserves the right to classify any boat/motor for display/identification purposes.
6. Items of race boat memorabilia to accompany the entry or to be used as an independent display are encouraged by the Race Boat Regatta Committee.
7. All **Water Operational** boats must provide sufficient pit crew to assist in launching, recovery and docking. Identifiable pit crew uniforms are encouraged.
